Budgeted income for APRIL was \$32,773

Currently monthly income and expense amounts have been used to show a quick financial picture . However, because more members are making yearly donations rather than weekly or monthly this method is no longer an accurate picture of where we stand. A better picture is the Year To Date (YTD) numbers. For this month only you are seeing both monthly and YTD amounts however, in the future you will only see the YTD amounts.

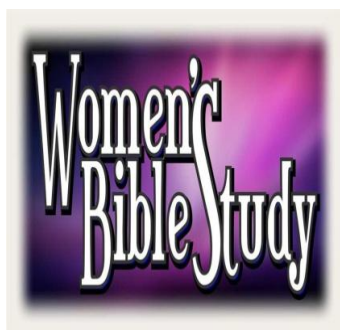
Emmaus Stephen Ministry
